PERFORMANCE ATTIRE

SHIRT - Solid white shirts. Solid white t-shirts and tank tops are permitted (and highly recommended). Please refrain from wearing high collars or turtle necks; long sleeved shirts may have to be rolled up. Please no prints, logos or patterns, or mid-drifts showing.

PANTS - Solid black full-length dress pants. We do not allow capri pants, striped, printed, faded or stonewashed jeans.

SHOES - Solid black shoes with solid black laces; they can be dress, casual, or athletic. Please choose shoes for comfort, as performers will be standing and walking for extended periods of time (High heels are NOT recommended!) For safety reasons we do NOT allow sandals, flip-flops, mules, boots, Uggs or bare feet at any time. Shoes should have no noticeable accents such as buckles or jewels.

SOCKS - Solid black socks or solid black hosiery are required and must come above the ankle.

JEWELRY - Please keep jewelry and accessories to a minimum. Earrings should not be larger than a quarter.

The above dress code requirements are mandatory for all performers. We will not have a supply of clothing/shoes for performers to borrow. Any students that do not meet production guidelines will not be permitted to perform and will forfeit their complimentary tickets.
